Candidates must complete the application in its entirety. Candidates must provide the job title associated with their public employment. Candidates must apply for either a 2-year or 4-year term.

Eligibility

A candidate for an Executive Trustee position must be an Employer Executive in continuing service as an Employer Executive from the date the candidate application is submitted through the election date of December 1st. A candidate for Executive Trustee shall be nominated by a petition signed by no fewer than 20 individuals who, as of the date of signing, were mayors of municipalities or presidents of fire protection districts that have participating pension funds.

Employer Executive Definition

“Employer Executive” means a person who is a mayor, president, chief executive officer, chief financial officer, or other officer, executive, or department head of a municipality or fire protection district that has a participating pension fund.

Executive Trustee Positions

- A) Two Executive Trustees shall be elected to serve a 4-year term.
- B) One Executive Trustee shall be elected to serve a 2-year term.
