Candidates must complete the application in its entirety. Candidates should list an Article 4 pension fund they currently participate in for their response to Participating Pension Fund.

**Candidate Eligibility**

A candidate for a Beneficiary Trustee position shall be a Beneficiary who remains a Beneficiary from the date the candidate application is submitted through the election date of December 1st. A candidate for Beneficiary Trustee shall be nominated by a petition signed by no fewer than 100 individuals who, as of the date of signing, were Beneficiaries.

“Beneficiary” means an Annuitant, Deferred Pensioner, or a Disabled Pensioner.

“Annuitant” means a retired firefighter receiving a retirement pension from a Participating Pension Fund.

“Deferred Pensioner” means a firefighter who has retired having accumulated enough creditable service to qualify for a pension under Article 4 of the Pension Code but who has not attained the required age for commencement of the pension.

“Disabled Pensioner” means a firefighter receiving a disability pension from a Participating Pension Fund.

“Participating Pension Fund” means any pension fund established pursuant to Article 4 of the Pension Code that has transferred securities, funds, assets, and moneys, and responsibility for custody and control of those securities, funds, assets, and moneys, to the Fund pursuant to Section 4-123.2 of the Illinois Pension Code.
